# **ATTENTION**

**For the safety of all of the volunteers, and participants involved in each event, the Wisconsin Senior Olympics will incorporate the following safety practices at all events**

## **Check-In Process**

- ◆ WSO Athletes and Volunteers will be assessed upon entry to check for signs of illness or exposure
- ◆ Temperature checked upon entry to each event (must fall within CDC Guidelines)
- ◆ Athletes will be required to answer a questionnaire regarding systems related to COVID-19
- ◆ Athletes and Spectators will be given a paper bracelet that they will put on their wrist to indicate that they have been successfully checked-in
- ◆ Athletes will proceed to adjacent table to pick up their Athlete Bag, which will be placed on the table
- ◆ Tape will be placed on the floor in front of the check-in table for social distancing
- ◆ Hand sanitizer will be available at the table
- ◆ Two cups of pens will be at the table, clean disinfected pens, and used pens (pens will be cleaned with disinfected wipes after each use)
- ◆ Volunteers will wear face protectant to cover their face/nose & mouth
- ◆ No onsite registration or changing of events will be allowed
- ◆ No financial transactions will take place
- ◆ Cleaning and disinfecting of surfaces will be done hourly
- ◆ Volunteers will wear disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and will discard after each use.

## **2020 Refund Policy**

Generally speaking, WSO does not issue refunds when you are unable to compete in events you signed up in. This year, we understand that there are many factors that reach beyond anyone's control. In the event the WSO cancels an event, fees associated with that event along with your general registration fee, if applicable, can be donated to the WSO, to help defray the costs associated with planning the 2020 season, or you may choose to have them credited to your account for use in the 2021 season, minus the appropriate fees associated with partners.

Wisconsin Senior Olympics partners with FuseSport for our athlete registration system in addition to Braintree, a PayPal affiliate, to register, collect and process athlete registrations. A portion of your registration covers the cost associated with these partnerships. Fees also support a portion of the cost of conducting the games, including medals, supplies, printing costs and independent contractors. Facility fees cover the costs of the sport including the venue and officials associated with that specific sport. Athletes have the option to register on our website or by mailing in a paper form. Both forms incur processing fees that are non-refundable.

## INFORMATION FOR REGISTRANTS

### **ATHLETES 40 YEARS and OLDER MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE WISCONSIN SENIOR OLYMPICS**

#### **Photo ID with Birthdate may be requested**

**There will be two registration closing dates, August 7th and August 24th, the closing date for each sport is shown at the end of each sport information section**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Men and Women who will be age 40 years and older as of Dec. 31, 2020. As the division is computer calculated based on the birth date, all participants must provide their birth date when registering for the Wisconsin Senior Olympics.

**AGE GROUPS:** Age groupings for events are in five year increments (e.g., 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59 etc.). Events will be conducted in these age groups where there is sufficient participation or age groups may be combined. You must compete in your proper age division, except in doubles and team events where you must compete in the age group of the youngest participant on your team.

**OUT OF STATE PARTICIPANTS:** WSO does accept out-of-state athletes and teams, however, an out-of-state athlete will not take away a medal spot from a Wisconsin athlete. This means there could be two winners for a medal. (i.e., one gold for the top Wisconsin athlete and one gold for the out-of-state athlete who finished ahead of the Wisconsin athlete.)

**MEDALS:** You must pick up medals the day of the event, if you leave early. **Medals will not be mailed.** You may pick them up at our offices with prior arrangements.

**T-SHIRTS:** T-shirts are not included with the registration fee. T-shirts are available starting at \$12, if ordered.

**TEAM INFORMATION:** Team roster must be submitted to the office by team captain by August 24. In order to qualify as a Wisconsin Team, the team must have more than 50% of the registered players reside in Wisconsin. Team clothing should be of like design and color with numbers on the front and back of the shirt.

**QUALIFICATION:** The National Senior Games Association (NSGA) runs the National Senior Games every other year in different cities throughout the United States. Athletes qualify to compete in the NSGA games during a qualifying year, which is defined as the year prior to the NSGA game. This year, the NSGA has an adjusted qualifying process for 2021 games. For additional information regarding this one time adjusted process, go to the NSGA website at [www.nsga.com](http://www.nsga.com) Athletes in the 2020 Wisconsin Senior Games may qualify for the 2021 Nationals in Greater Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The rules for qualification are on the NSGA website. NSGA has not added age brackets 40-44 and 45 to 49. Until they do so, athletes 40 years to 49 years will not be able to qualify for the National games.

**ONLINE REGISTRATION:** Wisconsin Senior Olympics partners with FuseSport for our online registration system. You can find the registration on our website [www.wiseniorolympics.com](http://www.wiseniorolympics.com). Athletes may still use the paper form, however, there is a \$8 paper registration fee to do so.

**POSTING OF RESULTS:** Results are manually entered into the FuseSport online system. With this system, results are easily transmitted to the National Senior Games for qualification purposes. **REGISTRATION FEE** includes participation in up to four sports. Fees also support a portion of the cost of conducting the games including medals, supplies, printing costs and independent contractors. Facility fees cover the costs of the sport including the venue and officials associated with that specific sport.

## MISSION STATEMENT

## CODE OF CONDUCT

The Wisconsin Senior Olympics (WSO) organization prides itself on our moral values of honesty, transparent communication, and teamwork. In turn, we expect these same values to be present in all participating athletes. All athletes are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct as established by WSO.

### STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR

Athletes are responsible for their words and actions while participating in WSO, and athletes shall comply with the following Code of Conduct:

- Treat all those involved in competition (umpires, athletes, spectators, administration) with respect.
- Demonstrate fair play and sportsmanship.
- Do not engage in the use of profanity or other offensive language.
- Follow the WSO and National Senior Olympics policies and official sport rules.
- Refrain from the use of tobacco and alcohol where prohibited. (School grounds, public buildings etc.)
- Athletes are responsible for their conduct from the time they reach the venue until the time they leave and are also encouraged to communicate this responsibility to any and all teammates.

Failure to abide by the rules and guidelines outlined by WSO may subject an athlete to disciplinary action enforced by the WSO Games Coordinator and/or Executive Committee. Depending on the severity of the infraction, disciplinary action may include, but not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Suspension
- Termination of playing privileges

The Wisconsin Senior Olympics organization reserves the sole authority to determine what, if any, disciplinary action is appropriate for any conduct infraction. Each situation will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
